If a parishioner is in a hospital other than Prince Philip Hospital, Llanelli, the Parish Priest of the area where the hospital is situated has to be the priest who is called upon. I am not free to enter, and minister in, another parish as if it is my own. But I also need help when visiting patients in Prince Philip. The switchboard has been centralised for the whole of the Hwel Dwa authority so when I am visiting hospital it is essential that I have the full name of the patient I am visiting. It would also be helpful if I have the patients date of birth. It is, unfortunately, the way things are done now!

Article 18 Petition Appeal

CALL TO PROTECT LIFE

As you may be aware, Kim Leadbeater's assisted suicide Bill failed in April after it ran out of time in the House of Lords. This means it did not become law. However, assisted suicide campaigners are now trying to bring the Bill back in this new parliamentary session.

A number of MPs who voted for the Bill last year have been drawn in the Private Members' Bill ballot, and they are now coming under pressure to use their slots to revive the Bill. The disability rights group **_Not Dead Yet UK_** has launched a new tool that enables people to email their MP explaining why bringing back the Leadbeater Bill would put people with disabilities at serious risk. Even if you have already contacted your MP about why the Bill should not be revived, it is important that you write again using this new tool. MPs need to hear clearly that many disabled people and disability rights campaigners are deeply concerned about the dangers this Bill would pose. Disability rights groups would be very grateful if you could help protect life by contacting your MP / AM again, or, if you have not done so previously, by contacting now.
